Round 10 of W.A.N.K.S. took place at the Joondalup huckfest which is part of the Joondalup festival. For the last 7 years freestyle now has been putting on the BMX comp at the festival. Much has changed in that time. I would have to say that most of the riders either competing or watching the comp were not at the first one but im sure that Ryan Sharpe was though.

Riders had competed all over the state to take home the number one title in park and flat. With Kie Ashworth taking himself out with a knee injury a few weeks before. This would make it easy for Ryan Gardiner to take the main title, even if he didn't make the finals (yeah right like that would happen). Even with that knowledge Ryan still had a lot of pressure going into this comp as if he would win it, it would be three wins in a row. In the flat comp it was going to be close to see who would take home the number one. Who ever would win the comp would take home the title. With \$1500 up for grabs thanks to the City of Joondalup it was going to be an unbelievable weekend.

At 7am Saturday morning I arrive with the freestyle now ramps in tow to meet up with the other ramp suppliers. Ive got 4 hours to design the course and set all ramps up. It is one of the hardest jobs to do, especially if the course won't work the way you had planned. Major bumner. The best part about the comp this year was the massive wall ride set up at one end. The DUDS and STUDS were competing in park on Saturday and Sunday and flat was on Sunday. It was going to be great comp.

In practice Carine local Tim owned the wall ride. As I was getting stuff ready at the time I didn't get to see but someone said that he was trying to stall the top of the wall. I would believe it. It was a pity he decided not to enter the comp though. Lots of huckers were ripping it up in practice but decide to sit and watch instead of competing. Each to their own but it would have been good to see some of them rip.

Come Sunday it was time to get the flatland comp under way. There was a great turn out. It was good to see some new riders and some who I thought had quit. Joel Kennedy was throwing down front wheel switches like he was at the casino with a stack of money. Nice to see him riding again. Matt Bielecki had the stick B's down and seemed to be smiling all the time. I (Shaun Jarvis) ended up getting 3rd with long flowing links with an original style. I rode as well as one could, considering I was running the competition. Aaron Bandy has been riding for ages now, and the time is starting to show with his fresh looking tricks coming out of his pockets 2nd. 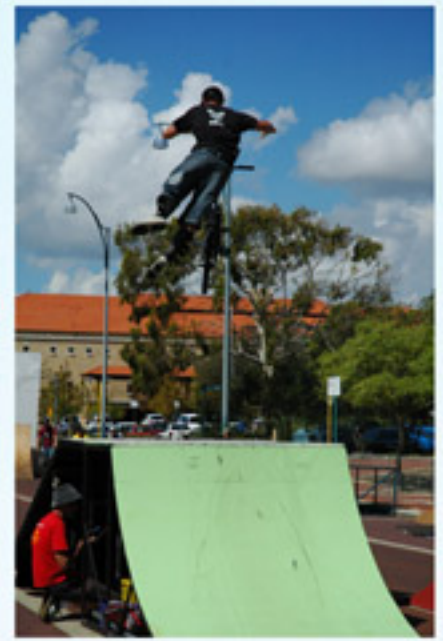

Jam format final is what they wanted so they got it and I think this may have had an effect on the placings. Jam format is good for riders but bad for judges. It's hard to keep track of riders and scores. Jamie Warren went fast, high and busted out some cool tricks and gaped from the spine to the box landing. He had a few crashes and ended up getting 4th. In a set run final im sure he would have place higher. Owen Dorren got super tech with his machine and took out 3rd. Whip to disaster, backflip over the box,



almost pulling fakie whips on the box landing and a flair attempt to bent bars on the quarter. 2nd went to Ryan Sharpe. He loved the wall. Massive Allyoop wall rides, wall ride to bars out, huge hucks over the box, fufanu the back rail of the quarter as well as the gap of the comp. From the jump box over the spine to land on the flat bank. For the third year in a row Ryan Gardiner won the competition. Ryan was super smooth, well tech, fast, consistent, and stylish. Gaped from spine to flat bank, hucked out a truckdriver, and barspin to icepick the sub box. With the win Ryan took home the \$500 first place prize money from the city of Joondalup and blitzed the year end title of W.A.N.K.S. and took \$100 cash from Freestyle Now. At the end of it all it was a great comp. The comp was full of banger tricks, bloody crashes, judging disappointments, hot looking girls, and plenty of hucking. Every thing that makes a competition good. Thanks go out to Jamie at stowaway for getting the prizes sorted, Kirra for helping out over the two days the City of Joondalup for every thing they did and to all the competitors. Next years is already in the planning and will again huck it up.

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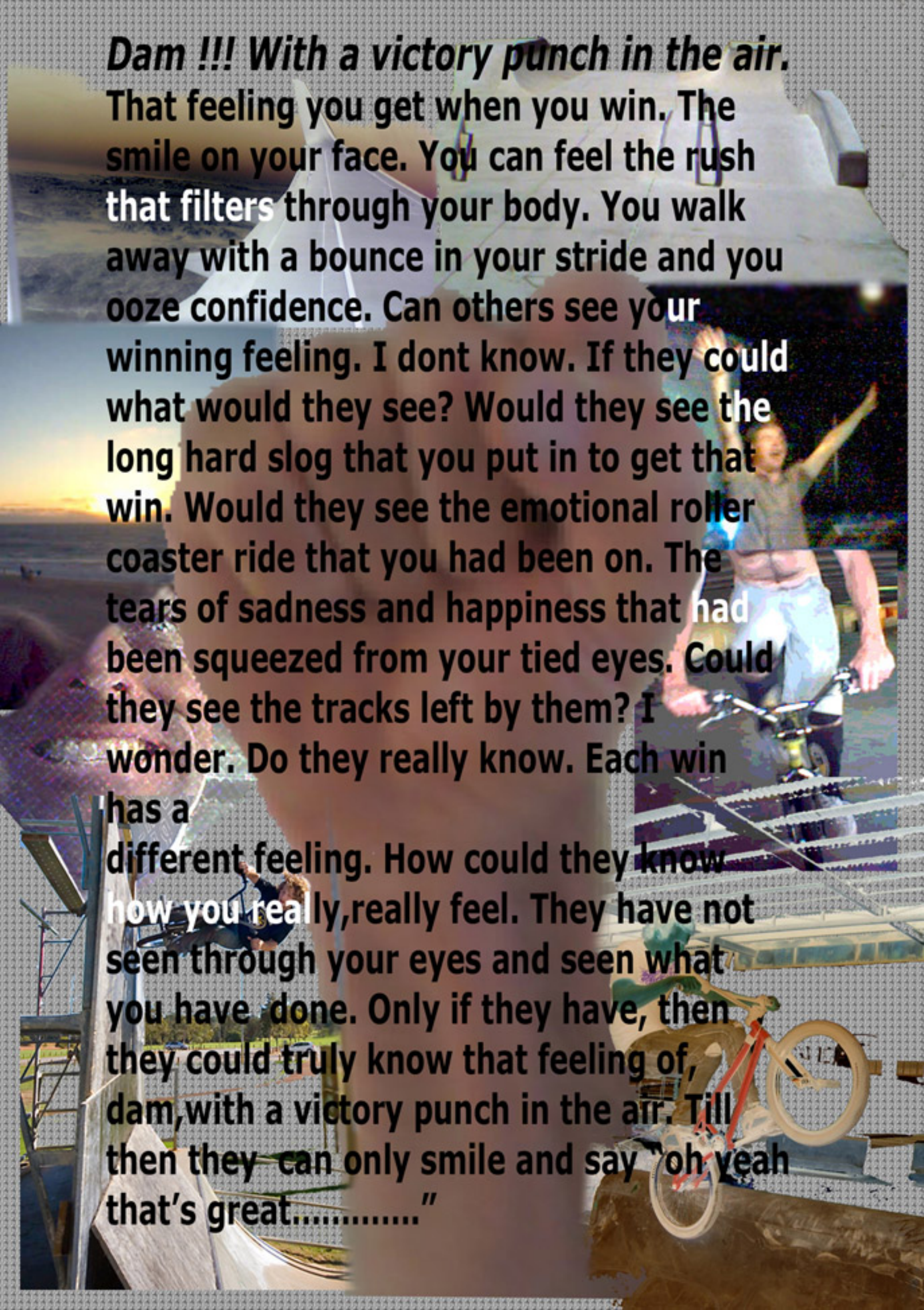


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Dam !!! With a victory punch in the air.

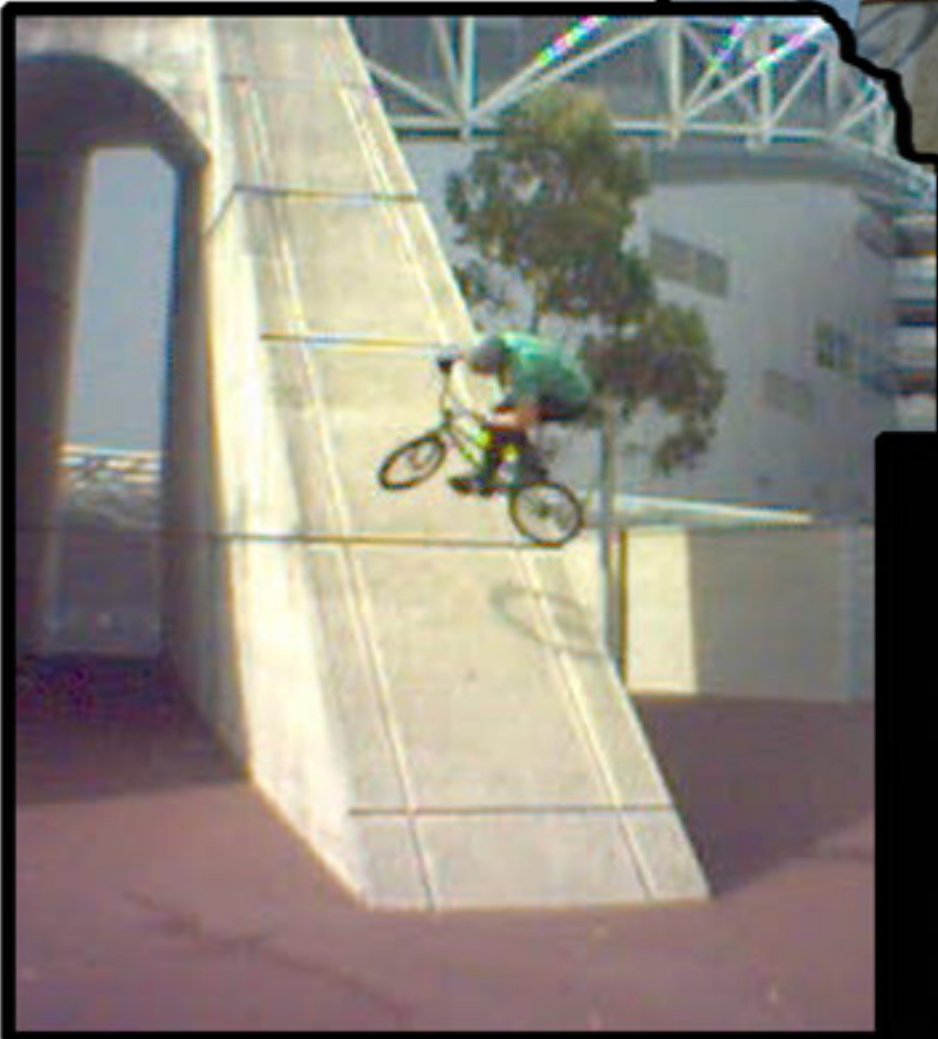
